

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF JOHNS CREEK CODE OF
ORDINANCES, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ORDINANCE, TO REVISE THE
DEFINITION OF HOTEL**

WHEREAS, the Johns Creek City Council approved a new Alcoholic Beverages Ordinance in November 2021;

WHEREAS, the definition of “hotel” has been revised in the Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the definition of “hotel” in the Alcohol Ordinance should be amended to be consistent with the definition provided in the Zoning Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Johns Creek hereby ordain that Alcoholic Beverages Ordinance, Article I, Section 6-2. be amended as follows:


Section 6-2. Definitions.

Hotel/Motel means a building in which lodging along with customary lodging facilities and services, such as meeting rooms, restaurant, housekeeping services and/or fitness center are provided for guests for an average stay of less than 30 days and offered to the public for compensation. Access to each guest room shall be through an inside lobby supervised at all hours.
