

# Jones Bridge Rd Merge Lane Extension

## *From State Bridge Road to Morton Road*

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

850-foot extension of Jones Bridge Road merge lane, southward from State Bridge Road to Morton Road.

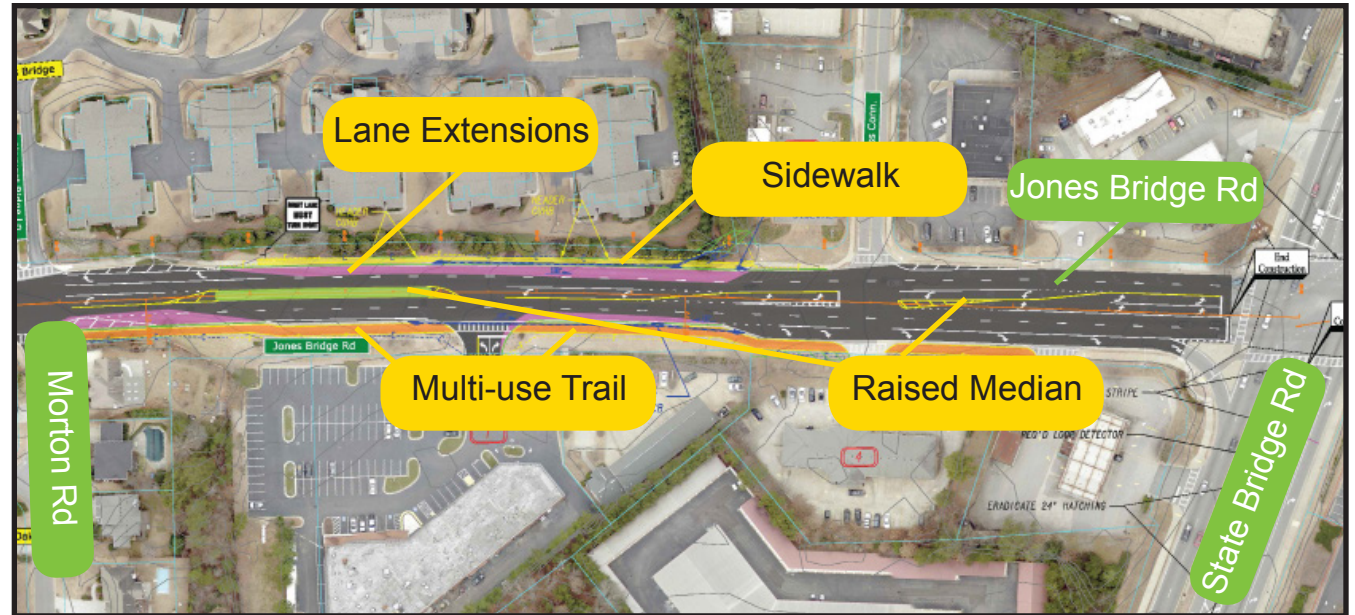
### PROJECT TIMELINE

Johns Creek City Council approved the project on August 10, 2015.

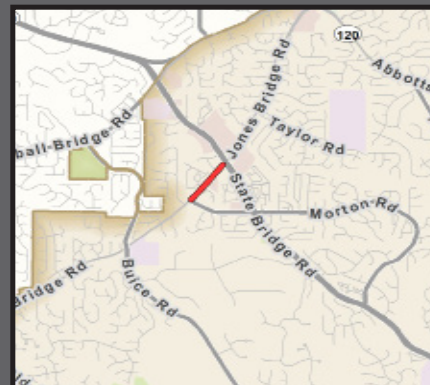
The project is scheduled to be finished in August 2016.

### KEY POINTS

- New merge-lane extension allows more time for south-bound motorists to ease into traffic flow.
- Motorists will have an additional 850 feet to merge into the single southbound lane.
- Reduces congestion at the Jones Bridge/State Bridge intersection
- Merge lane eventually will become part of a project to widen Jones Bridge Road from two to four lanes between State Bridge and Waters roads.

### ADDITIONAL IMPROVEMENTS

- Project also consists of a second northbound lane for the entire project length
- Westbound approach of State Bridge Rd to be restriped to allow for a dual left turn lane onto south bound Jones Bridge
- 5-foot sidewalk on the west side
- 8-10-foot wide multi-use trail on the east side
- Drainage improvements
- Resurfacing
