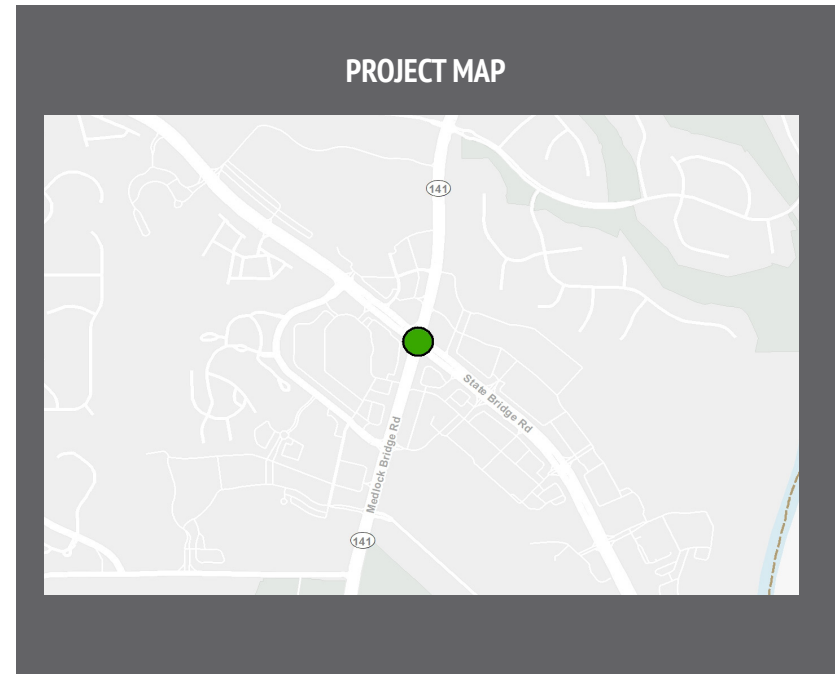


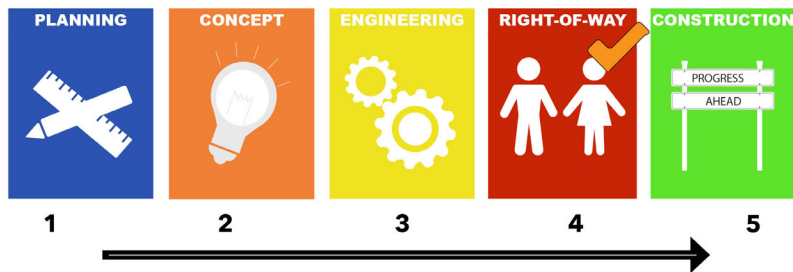


Medlock Bridge Road at State Bridge Road

Phase 1



Project Current Phase:



Where: Medlock Bridge Road at State Bridge Road

Why: Faster travel, less congestion

Who: City of Johns Creek, GDOT

When: Construction in 2022

Current Issues:

- Traffic congestion at Medlock Bridge Road (State Route 141) and State Bridge Road
- Critical intersection feeding Johns Creek's economy
- Most congested intersection in North Fulton County

Proposed Solution:

- Restriping to 3 southbound lanes on Medlock Bridge and widening State Bridge for 3 eastbound and westbound lanes
- Project cost: \$2.5 million
- Lengthening left-turn lane on eastbound State Bridge Road

Anticipated Results:

- Creating a foundation for Phase 2 of the Medlock/State intersection improvements, and kick-starts congestion relief
- Improved operations at the busiest intersection in the city by accommodating high volumes with minimal footprint changes
- Decreased congestion for turning movements
- Improved flow of traffic
- Reduces delay by 10% or 50 seconds
