

### Mission



# PROBATION

As of July 1, 2025, the City of Johns Creek Municipal Court has the authority per the Georgia Department of Community Supervision (DCS), Misdemeanor Probation Oversight Unit (MPOU), to provide general probation services as an internal-governmental entity. Therefore, probation services are now offered in person at Johns Creek City Hall under the direction of the Municipal Court. This allows the City of Johns Creek to better serve its citizens and community with a more focused approach, solely on those individuals that do business with the Johns Creek Municipal Court that require the services of probation supervision. The goal of the Probation Division is to promote justice, rehabilitation services, and community safety.
